Earning your Canadian *transcript digitally*

Providing the opportunity to obtain an internationally recognized high school diploma online, Ontario eSchool gives students the luxury of time and environment.

Since its establishment in 2007, Ontario eSchool has been a renowned online education provider giving students the accreditations they need in order to pursue future endeavors. While a majority of students receive their education through going to school physically, some choose to do so digitally and there are many benefits that come with it.

Ontario eSchool offers more than 50 online courses for students from grade 9 to 12, which can be taken anytime of the year. The courses are all taught by Ontario certified teachers that are committed to academic excellence and will prepare students to exceed their expectations.

One of the key requirements of entering a Canadian school is demonstrating satisfactory English capabilities. With this in mind, most international students are required to take one or

more English as a Second Language (ESL) courses. Ontario eSchool allows students to start their ESL course online in their home country, and keep pace with their other courses.

For students that are at the end of their high school career, Ontario eSchool offers all Ontario high school credit courses, which can count towards earning their Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD).

The OSSD is a globally-recognized high school diploma and the key to many North American universities. For the academic portion of the diploma, students are required to complete 30 credits worth of courses. Local students are allowed to transfer up to 24 credits from their past courses. The other six credits can be earned through Ontario eSchool and will take three to six months to complete.

Alan Chan, Director of Operation, Asia at Ontario eSchool, commented that local students approaching their final year of high school can choose to attend the online school instead. "Students that are aiming towards attending school in Canada, we offer a different path," says Chan. "Our courses allow students to become familiar with Canadian teaching and will blend into the education system right away when they start their school term in Canada."

Ontario eSchool also offers a IELTS / TOEFL Preparation Program which provides students with all they need to get ready for the actual TOEFL/



IELTS exam and grade 12 high school academic English. The course focuses on academic material that is found in first year university programs. Students will be practicing various skills such as, reading comprehension, listening to various academic sources, speaking and writing academic essays.

Examination for courses can be taken online but for those who are more comfortable taking it physically, the school has a centre in Jordan.
